What age is this skill/activity appropriate for?	Preteen (9-12)
Any special materials needed to lead this activity?	The story is to instill and inspire excitement and wonder. Quickie bows can be made with many woods that involves harvesting / care-taking lessons. Simple carving and tillering of the bow with a knife. Make a string or use jute, para cord or utility cord. Arrows are made with cat tail shafts, feather, glue and natural fibers. Also added to the tip is a small nerf ball for safety and allows for many fun games.
